# Eclipse Workbench

- As described in the *Composer Deployment Guide*, Composer 8.1.3 is installed as an Eclipse plugin.

Since Composer is based on **Eclipse**, you should familiarize yourself with basic Eclipse concepts by referring to the *Workbench User Guide*. The *Workbench User Guide* presents an overview of many of the same concepts used within Composer, but from the Eclipse development environment framework perspective. Reviewing this information is valuable as a first step in getting familiar with the Eclipse user interface on which Composer is based. To access the *Workbench User Guide* online help:

1. Select **Help > Help Contents**. The system displays the Help - Composer window.
2. In the Contents navigation pane, click **Workbench User Guide**.
3. Click **Concepts** in the main Help pane.

Review the multiple sections of the Concepts section to gain familiarity with Eclipse.

- Select Search from the main Help menu to search the Eclipse Help.
