Flow Control Elements

Flow Control elements are used to conditionally execute certain actions or repeat actions several times, based on values in an array.

<foreach>

Encapsulates a block of XML elements that are executed multiple times based on the number of items within the JavaScript array that is specified in the **array** attribute.

Attributes

Name	Type	Description	Default	Values
array	string (required)	Specifies a JavaScript array. The elements contained within the <foreach> element are executed a number of times, based on the content of the variable.	—	—
index	string (required)	Specifies the name of a JavaScript variable which contains the index value as the execution loops through the specified array. The index value can be used as a JavaScript variable within the XML content that is encapsulated by the <foreach> element.	—	—

Encapsulates a block of XML elements that are executed only if the **cond** attribute evaluates to the value true.
