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TMakeCall

Description

Originates a regular call from the telephony object specified by the parameter `dn` to the called party specified by the parameter `destination`.

Parameters

Name	Description
<code>server</code>	Local server handle to the T-Server in question.
<code>dn</code>	Directory number of the telephony object from which the call is requested to be made.
<code>destination</code>	Directory number of the party that should be dialed.
<code>location</code>	Name of the remote location in the form of <code><SwitchName></code> or <code><T-ServerApplicationName>@<SwitchName></code> .
<code>call_type</code>	Refer to the type TMakeCallType .
<code>user_data</code>	A pointer to the user data that should be attached to the call.
<code>reasons</code>	A pointer to a data structure that provides additional information associated with this action.
<code>extensions</code>	A pointer to an additional data structure.
