WFM Server memory management is improved when the **[ScheduleService] EnableCoverageCache** configuration option value is set to 1. Previously, setting this option value to 1 caused excessive memory use over time. (WFM-25822)

In the Web for Supervisors **Forecast** module, site activity split values are now correctly calculated when, schedule-based multi-site to single-site activity splitting is enabled for the Interaction Volume and the activity site time zone is later than the multi-site activity time zone. (Resolves known issue WFM-25548). (WFM-25709)
