WFM has improved verification of time-off constraints, significantly reducing the time it takes to insert or modify time-off states in the schedule. (WFM-32298)

WFM now autogrants full-day time-off requests when the following conditions are met:

- The paid hours in the time-off rule is 0:00.
- The minimum requested time-off in the the time-off rule is greater than 0.
- The WFM Server configuration option [CalendarService] DetermineFullDayTimeOffStartEndPaidHours is set to true.

Previously in this scenario, WFM failed to autogrant full-day time-off requests, even if these conditions were met. (WFM-32207)
