What's New

This release contains the following new features and enhancements:

- **Support for OpenJDK 11**—Note: To run iWD Runtime Node on JDK 8 with the MSSQL database, you must provide a JDBC driver for MSSQL manually. See the Prerequisites section on the [iWD](#) page in the [Genesys Supported Operating Environment Reference Guide](#) for more detailed information and a list of all prerequisites. (IWD-8449)
- The performance of the KETTLE version of the [AGE plugin](#) has been improved. Outdated information about AGE_TYPE has also been removed from the iWD Data Mart Reference Guide. (IWD-8425)
- iWD Data Mart now provides built-in 'native' aggregation plugins. Genesys recommends using native plugins because they provide better performance, especially in heavy load cases. This release contains the following resolved issues:

Incorrect values for Min, Max and overall handle time (OHT) in the Resource Performance Report have been fixed. (IWD-8589)

Data Mart now correctly upgrades the MSSQL database when views TODAY, RELATIVE_RANGE and GI2_CONSTANTS already exist. Previously the upgrade failed in this scenario. (IWD-8475)

Upgrade Notes

No special procedure is required to upgrade to release 9.0.009.08.
