### Resolved Issues

This release contains the following resolved issues:

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To avoid nuisance warnings, Media Control Platform (MCP) now strips out the MRCP protocol in X-Genesys-Speech-Engine-TTS and X-Genesys-Speech-Engine-ASR headers when sending requests to the MRCPv2 Proxy. (GVP-43615, GVP-43119)

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MCP now supports Opus format recording with configurable bitrates. The MPC option **mpc.opus.bitrate** specifies the Opus maximum encoding bitrate in Kbits/second, or 0 to use the Opus codec default, which is 12 kbps for NB codecs. (GVP-42623)

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MCP no longer shuts down unexpectedly when media passthrough is enabled and the three-party conference is torn down. (GVP-41023)
